Job Description:

OFSHEEA is currently creating a resource that supports teachers in the Fashion classroom and lab. Our aim is to create resources that will help students learn the skills they need to know in the fashion lab while supporting teachers, especially during current times. **We are looking for two reviewers for this document.**

The resource will include resources for both the teacher and the student and will cover topics such as:

- supervision in the lab
- safe use and maintenance of equipment
- teacher/school/board responsibilities
- communicating with parents (templates of letters and other communications)
- understanding the varied needs of the learner in the family studies fashion lab
- classroom ready resources with a focus on incorporating technology, UDL and is culturally responsive

Qualifications and Skills for the Job:

- Possess a current Ontario Certificate of Qualification with teaching qualifications in Family Studies
- Must be a current member of OFSHEEA
- Experience in the last 3 years teaching Family Studies in Ontario schools
- Experience in teaching the fashion courses, especially teaching hands-on labs in Face-to-face and/or virtual classrooms
- Demonstrated ability to create engaging and creative lessons incorporating technology, differentiation, UDL and are culturally responsive
- Previous writing and reviewing curriculum experience (preferred but not necessary)
- Excellent written communication skills (clarity, proper syntax, spelling and grammar)

Duties of the Job:

The chosen candidates will be responsible for working with the team to review teacher and student materials. The reviewer will:

• review according to established timelines, all teacher and student materials and activities and communicate to the writing team using guidelines provided to you from the Project Lead

- provide direction, feedback, and input into the pedagogical value of the teaching materials (to include but not limited to incorporating technology, differentiation, UDL, culturally responsive practices) and assessment strategies;
- ensure that the materials created are cohesive and unified (i.e., similar writing voice, similar types of images, similar language)
