



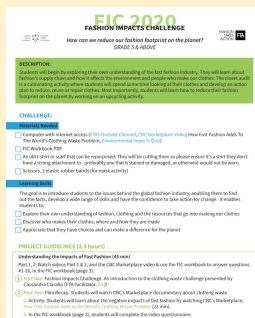

future climate leaders!

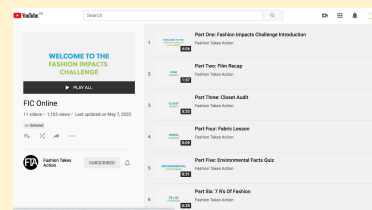
workshop & workbook (grades 4-12, incl. videos, quizzes) that coordinate around school theme days such as **#buynothingday**, **#sweaterday**,

challenges to reduce textile waste such as **6for6**: wearing only 6 chosen outfits for 6 weeks; **REwear Friday**: wearing the same outfit every Friday for a

period of time and a closet audit; a **Closet Audit** to understand how to lower their clothing footprint.
