

POSITIONS UP FOR ELECTION AND VACANCIES FOR 2022

Positions for Election and Procedure:

(The election procedure was modified to the new *Democratic Rules of Order*. The process will be simpler and look quite different from the past as we are no longer using *Robert's Rules of Order*. Note you no longer need 2 nominators, one will be sufficient.)

The following seven positions are up for election for the 2022 to 2024 term and nominations are being sought for them. To be considered on-time, nominations are due <u>October 24, 2022</u>. Elections will occur at the AGM on October 29, 2022.

President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary Central East Regional Director, Central West Regional Director and Toronto Regional Director

What do I do to run for a position?

1.	Submit your nomination for one of the positions by emailing ofsheea@ofsheea.ca
	or a member of the OFSHEEA Board of Directors by Monday October 24th.
	You can simply email us a written statement that you intend to run for the
	position. The nominator must be an OFSHEEA member. The Nomination Chair
	will confirm receipt of your nomination.

- 2. Note if you do not have a nominator, you can let us know and we can ask for a nominator at the Annual General Meeting to approve your nomination.
- 3. If more than one person runs for a position, the nominations chair will let you know at least 5 days in advance so you can write a speech for the election if you choose to do so. Elections will be held at the AGM.
- 4. If no on-time nominations are received, then nominations will be sought from the floor at the AGM and if necessary positions will be filled by the Board of the Directors at the fall board meeting.
