Job Description:

OFSHEEA is seeking two secondary OCTs to work collaboratively with other team members to plan and create materials and present a virtual workshop on *How to Teach a Fashion Lab* to pre-service family studies teacher candidates. The workshop will occur *Saturday February 20, 2021* from 10am - 3pm.

Qualifications and Skills for the Job:

Possess a current Ontario Certificate of Qualification with teaching qualifications in family studies,
individual and society, or social science
Must be a current member of OFSHEEA
Experience in the last 3 years teaching family studies or social science courses in the Social Science and
Humanities Curriculum (edition 2013)
Experience in teaching the fashion courses, especially teaching hands-on clothing labs and proper hand
and machine sewing skills
Demonstrated ability to create engaging, creative, demonstrations and lessons.
Excellent written communication skills (clarity, proper spelling and grammar).
Strong presentation skills in a virtual environment.

Duties of the Job:

The chosen candidate will be responsible for working with the team to plan and create workshop materials and present on February 20, 2021 (10am - 3pm) using Zoom. The successful candidate will work with the team to create a resource package for participants including lab planning and procedures, safety instruction, and assessment tools. Upon completion of the workshop the chosen candidate will provide feedback to OFSHEEA about the workshop.

The successful candidate must have access and ability to use Zoom to attend planning meetings and present the workshop.

All materials created/shared must clearly connect to Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum and guidelines (i.e. Growing Success/Learning for All). Lesson materials will also become the property of OFSHEEA
